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Welcome to R&C

R&C — Reading & Comprehension — helps you master the vocabulary that powers real careers. Whether you are a preschooler just starting out, a student, a professional, or a lifelong learner, R&C builds your command of language across critical domains through clear, interactive lessons.

You do not need an account. Just open the app, choose your level, pick a domain, and start learning. Your progress is saved automatically on your device.

What Makes R&C Different

 **Multilingual** — R&C speaks your language. The app is fully available in English, French, Spanish and Portuguese, and detects your device language automatically the first time you open it. You can switch language anytime from the home screen.

 **Real-World Context** — Every word is taught with a clear definition, an example sentence, and a real-life connection showing how it appears in careers and everyday life.

 **Coin Rewards** — Earn gold coins for completing lessons, writing thoughtful answers, and finishing the Sentence Builder. Coins track your effort and keep motivation high.

 **Works Offline** — Your lessons, progress and coins are stored on your device. No internet required — learn anywhere, anytime.

Getting Started

Step 1 — Choose Your Level

R&C has four levels designed for different ages and stages of life. Tap the level that matches you on the home screen.

Level	Best For	Focus
Level 0	Ages 3–5 · Preschool & Pre-K	First words and ideas — early literacy,

		early numbers, first science
Level 1	Ages 5–12 · Elementary & Middle School	Foundational concepts with fun, relatable examples
Level 2	Ages 13–18 · High School	Deeper understanding with career connections
Level 3	Ages 19+ · Adults & Professionals	Professional mastery with industry-level depth

✓ **Tip:** You can switch levels at any time from the home screen. Each level has its own set of lessons and its own progress tracking.

Step 2 — Pick a Domain

The home screen shows the learning domains available for your level. Each domain has a progress bar showing how many lessons you have completed. Tap any domain to see its lesson list.

Levels 1–3 share seven domains:

New in 1.4: the Accounting domain now includes money-skills lessons — Profit, Loss, Revenue, Interest and Savings, and at higher levels Principal, Rate, Compound Interest, Simple Interest and Return — so you learn the words to talk about how money and interest grow.

	Science	Molecules, ecosystems, forces, experiments and the language of discovery
	Engineering	Systems, materials, circuits, design thinking and how things are built
	Mathematics	Numbers, patterns, equations, statistics and mathematical reasoning
	Business	Strategy, markets, leadership, operations and entrepreneurship
	Financial Reporting	Balance sheets, income statements, ratios and investor communication
	Accounting	Debits, credits, auditing, compliance and financial records
	Infrastructure	Networks, logistics, civil systems and the backbone of society

Level 0 (Preschool) offers three gentle starter domains:

Icon	Domain	What You Will Learn
	Early Literacy	Letters, sounds, simple words, and what it means to read
	Early Math	Counting, numbers, simple shapes and comparing amounts



Note: Level 0 is designed for very young learners. Lessons use simple words, friendly examples, and the read-aloud button so a child can listen along with a grown-up.

How a Lesson Works

Every lesson follows the same clear structure. Here is what to expect from the moment you tap a lesson card.

The Word Card

Each lesson opens with a word card showing everything you need to understand the vocabulary:

- The word — large, bold and easy to read
- Definition — written clearly for your level
- Example sentence — showing the word in context
- Real Life connection — how this word appears in careers and everyday life
- Speaker icon — tap to hear the word and text spoken aloud

Tip: Tap the speaker icon as many times as you like. Hearing a word while reading it dramatically improves retention — and it is especially helpful for younger learners and for practising a new language.

Think About It — The Question

After reading the word card, scroll down to find a question that invites you to think about the concept in your own words. There is no single right answer — the goal is to engage with the idea, not just recall a definition.

Type your answer in the text box. Writing even a sentence or two helps the idea stick — and a thoughtful answer of ten words or more earns bonus coins.

Note: Example question for "Molecule" (Level 1, Science): "If you could shrink down to the size of a molecule of water, what do you think you would see around you?"

Hints and Sample Answers

Stuck? Two helpers are always available:

Hint — Tap this for a gentle nudge in the right direction. Using a hint costs 5 coins from your reward, so try to answer first.

Answer — Shows a model answer you can compare against your own. Use this to learn, not to copy.

The Sentence Builder

Some lessons include a Sentence Builder — an interactive puzzle where you arrange word tiles (or type freely) to form a correct sentence using the new vocabulary. Completing it earns extra coins.

Completing a Lesson

After working through the question (there may be two per lesson), tap Next to move forward. When the lesson is complete you will see your coin reward:

- 10 coins — for completing the lesson
- +5 coins — if you did not use a hint
- +10 coins — for a thoughtful written answer (ten words or more)
- +10 coins — for completing the Sentence Builder

 **Note:** Your total coins are shown on the home screen. They track your cumulative effort across all lessons and all domains, and they never reset.

Tips for Getting the Most from R&C

Learning Strategies That Work

- 1. Read the whole word card before answering.** The definition, example and real-life sections all give you material to draw from.
- 2. Use your own life in your answer.** The best answers connect the vocabulary word to something real in your experience — personal connections stick longer than abstract definitions.
- 3. Do not rush.** Spend a little time thinking before typing. A thoughtful answer is its own reward — and earns more coins.
- 4. One domain at a time.** Completing a full domain builds cumulative vocabulary. Words in later lessons often reference concepts from earlier ones.
- 5. Use the speaker for every new word.** Hearing a word spoken correctly is as important as knowing what it means — and helps in any language.

Your Progress

The home screen shows a progress bar for each domain. Completed lessons are marked with a green tick in the lesson list. Your total coins accumulate permanently — they never reset.

If your teacher has set up a classroom, you can join it and receive assignments by scanning a QR code. When you finish an assignment, your app shows a completion code you can show your teacher so they can record that you're done — see "Joining a Class & Finishing Assignments" below.

Joining a Class & Finishing Assignments

If your teacher uses R&C, they can share a class or an assignment with you as a QR code. On the home screen tap **+** Join a Class," then "Scan QR Code," and point your camera at the code your teacher shows you. You'll be asked for your name, then taken straight to your assigned lessons.

Work through the lessons just like normal. When you've finished every lesson in the assignment, tap "Show completion code." Your app displays your own QR code — show it to your teacher so they can scan it and record that you're done. Everything stays on your device; the code is just a quick, private way to tell your teacher you finished.

On a shared classroom tablet, you can instead type the join code by hand. On your own phone or tablet, scanning is the way to go.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to create an account?

No. R&C works entirely without an account. Your progress is stored on your device automatically.

Which languages does R&C support?

English, French, Spanish and Portuguese. The app picks your device language the first time you open it, and you can change it anytime from the home screen.

What ages is R&C for?

Everyone. Level 0 is for preschoolers (ages 3–5), Level 1 for ages 5–12, Level 2 for ages 13–18, and Level 3 for adults and professionals.

What happens if I close the app mid-lesson?

Your completed lessons are saved. If you close during a lesson you will need to restart that lesson, but all previously completed lessons are preserved.

Does R&C work without internet?

Yes — all lessons work completely offline.

Can I change my level?

Yes — tap a different level on the home screen at any time. Each level has its own complete set of lessons and its own progress tracking.

Why does the speaker not work?

Audio pronunciation works on real devices. If you are using a simulator or emulator the audio may be silent — this is a known limitation of testing environments, not a bug in the app.
